Parthenon to Get \$10,000 Bequest From Cowan Will

Bequest of \$10,000 to the Parthenon as an endowment fund with interest to be used in the care of the approximately \$100,000 worth of paintings he gave to Nashville during his lifetime is made in the will of James M. Cowan, former resident of Tennessee, which has been filed in probate court at Aurora, Ill., according to word received here.

After Mr. Cowan's death, on December 9, he was revealed as the unknown donor of the art treasures to Nashville, which he had made with the request that his name not be disclosed.

His will also leaves several hundred thousand dollars worth of paintings to an art institute to be formed in Aurora, it being stipulated that a \$50,000 art gallery be erected to house them within two years after his death.

If the stipulation is not complied with, the will provides that the paintings be given to the city of Nashville, which also would have to construct a \$50,000 art gallery to gain possession.

PLANS DRAWN FOR \$35,000 CHURCH

Hillsboro Church of Christ To Have Another Edifice.

Plans and specifications for a new church edifice to cost in the neighborhood of \$35,000, exclusive of equipment, have been approved by both the building committee and the congregation of the Hillsboro road between Blair boulevard and Ashwood avenue. It will be of brick construction with cut stone trim and will contain an auditorium with seating capacity of approximately 500 persons, nine departmental rooms and eleven classrooms. It will be of modified Grecian style of architecture.

Basement of the church was completed about two years ago and the congregation has held its meetings and services there since that time. The building will be erected on the present foundations. The eleven classrooms will be located in the basement and the nine departmental rooms on two upper floors.

It is planned to have the structure completed by August 1.
